

Refrigerant Troubleshooting

My system is freezing up. What does that mean?

Freezing up is referred to when your system is building ice in cooling mode. The ice starts on the evaporator coil due to an air flow restriction or refrigerant issue. Examples of an air flow problem would be a dirty air filter, dirty coils, detached cainet insulation or a collapsed duct. Refrigerant problems such as a low refrigerant charge or refrigerant flow problems can cause freezing up to.
